By registering my child with OCRFC I confirm that I have read and agree to the following:

COVID-19: All children must have their attendance confirmed on Spond by midnight Friday before the session. By accepting the invite and attending you are confirming that you, your child and other members of your family are free from Covid-19 symptoms including a temperature, persistent cough or loss of smell and also are not under instruction to self-isolate or quarantine for any other reason.

PARENTAL CARE: I understand that I or a nominated person will remain on the Club grounds whilst my child is present, whether at home or away. If I arrange for another adult to take responsibility I will also inform the Age Group Head Coach.

MEDICAL CONSENT: In the event of an accident or injury where the coach is unable to contact either of the contacts given, then I give permission for the coach present to sign the authorisation for any medical treatment or procedure which may be required. I further consent to qualified first aiders to offer first aid treatment if required.

I also acknowledge my responsibility to inform the coaching team of any injury that my child has suffered outside of Rugby sessions.

RIGHT OF REMOVAL: I understand that the OCRFC Coaches reserve the right to remove a player from a session or match if they believe that they are unwell, injured, unduly disruptive or inappropriately dressed for the conditions.
